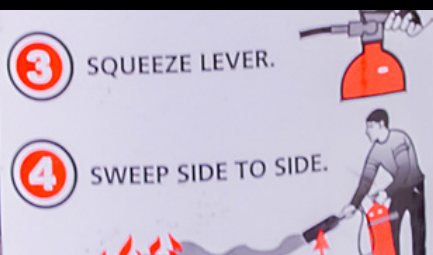

Pricing

The table below displays our average fire risk assessment costs.

Building Type	Range - Low	Range - High	Average
Low level	£150	£500	£330
Medium level	£250	£600	£430
High level	£350	£1000	£675

Discounts can be considered if multiple Fire Risk Assessments are required

Low-level includes - cafes, beauty salons, dental practices and convenience stores

Mid-level includes - schools, hotels, industrial premises, warehouses and factories

High-level includes - blocks of flats/apartments, council housing and sheltered housing
